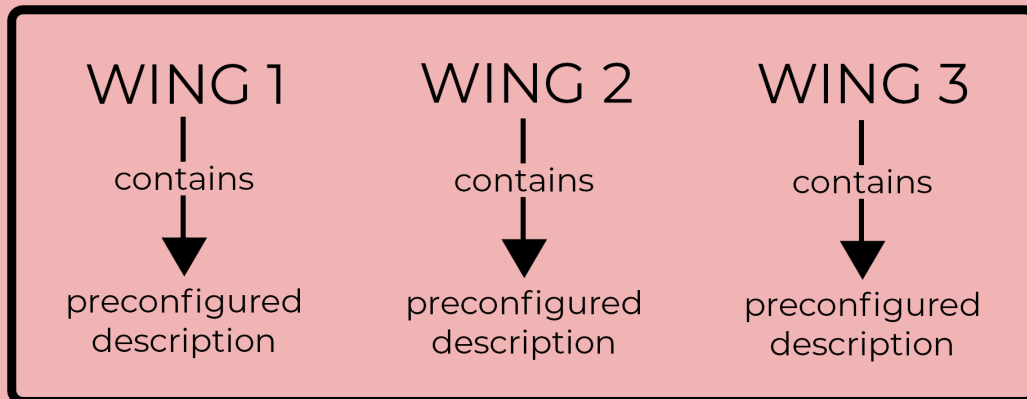
Description

Phlunt's Golem Secretary (patent pending) is a specialized Discord bot that has been designed to post scheduled messages for the Guild Wars 2 Nikart raiding team. These messages contain information relating to the raiding teams plans for the current week. Furthermore, the bot can create fractal events displaying the current fractal dailies and post reminders for the weekly time gated material known as "Antique Summoning Stones" or "ASS".

EXAMPLE SCHEDULE OF 2 WEEKS

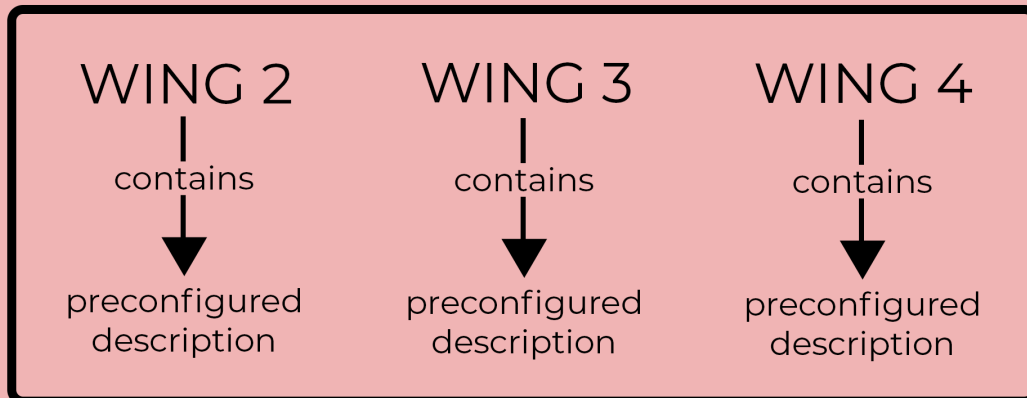

To accomplish this, the bot needs to be configured to the relevant channels (see 'setting up') and a schedule needs to be written. A schedule is a configured number of weeks and every week contains three so called "raid wings". Raid wings must also be created beforehand.

EXAMPLE MESSAGE FOR WEEK 1

@Static

Next week is **week one** - *Spirit Vale (Sabetha), Salvation Pass (Matthias), Stronghold of the Faithful (Xera)*

Please react for the following:

- ★ That you will tank next week
- 🙏 That you will heal (2 please)
- 👊 That you will provide Might
- 5 That you will provide Quickness (2 please)
- 10 That you will provide Alacrity

→ RAID MESSAGE

Wing 1:

- ☢️ That you will do Red Guardian (2 please)
- 🔴 That you will do Seekers (2 please)
- 🕸️ That you will do immobilize
- 🌪️ That you will do orbs
- 🔫 That you will do cannons (2 please)

→ WING 1 DESCRIPTION

Wing 2:

- 🍄 That you will do mushrooms (4 please)
- 💡 That you will do stunbreaks
- 🔫 That you will do mortars
- 🔪 That you will do saboteurs
- 🪞 That you will do reflects

→ WING 2 DESCRIPTION

Wing 3:

- 🏠 That you will do cave & portal
- 👾 That you will do back warg
- 👤 That you will do Glenna
- 👉 That you will do pushing

→ WING 3 DESCRIPTION

And finally 🚫 if something urgent comes up and you will not be here!

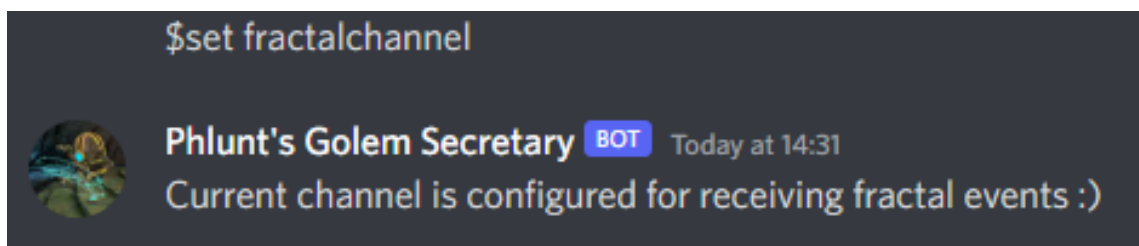
Known absences - (insert known names here or leave it as "no known absences") (edited)

The bot will then post weekly messages containing the descriptors of all the configured raid wings for that week AND a general message that will always be added. This message is known as the raid message and can, for example, be used to list sign ups for boon roles that are relevant to each wing.

Setting up

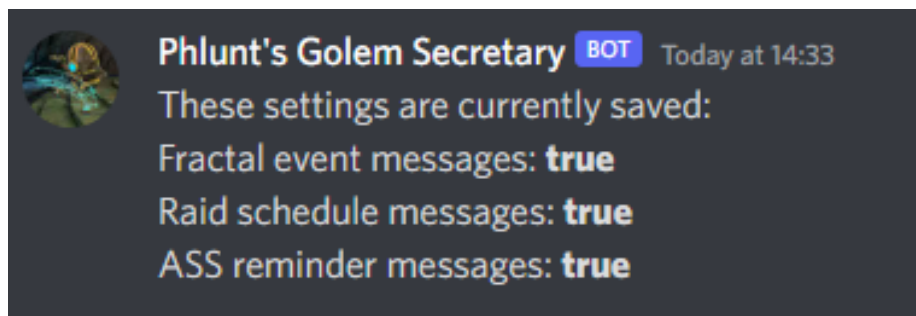
Before the bot can be used there are a few settings that need to be configured. First of all, the channels in which the bot will post messages need to be specified. There are three channels the bot will use; the fractal channel, the reminder channel and the raid schedule channel. The fractal channel will post daily fractal events, the reminder channel will post weekly 'Antique Summoning stones' reminders and the raid schedule channel will post raid schedules. **These will need to be different channels** because the bot will delete previous announcements to prevent flooding the channel. To set these up, type the following commands in the target channels:

- **\$set fractalchannel**
- **\$set reminderchannel**
- **\$set raidchannel**



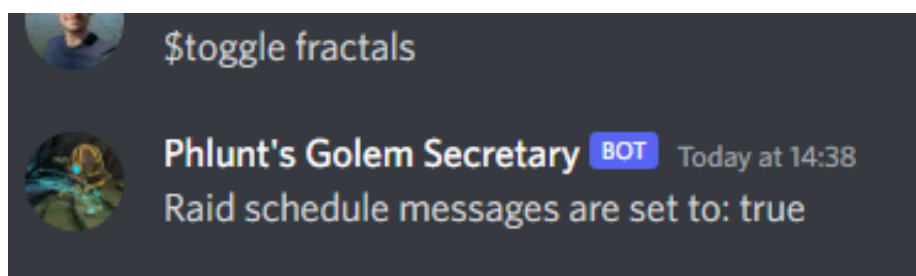
Make sure the relevant timed messages are enabled by checking the config with:

- **\$display config**



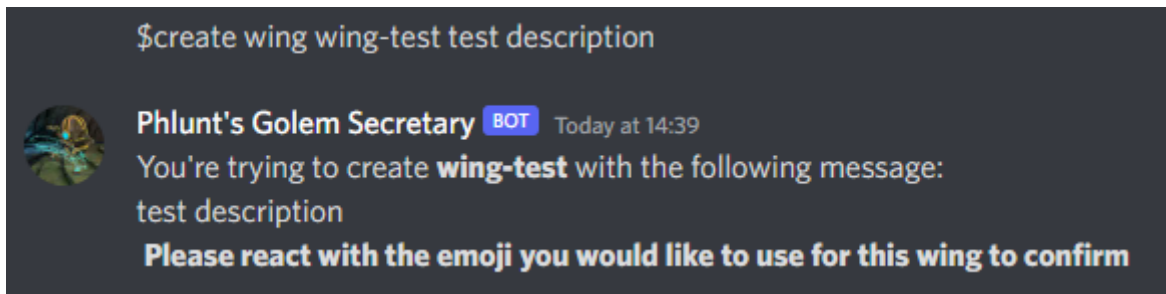
If they are not enabled, you can enable them with:

- **\$toggle fractals**
- **\$toggle ass**
- **\$toggle raids**



Now that the configurations of the messages are set up, you'll have to create a raid schedule for the bot to post raid messages. To create a schedule, we first need to create at least three raid wings. We do this by using the following command:

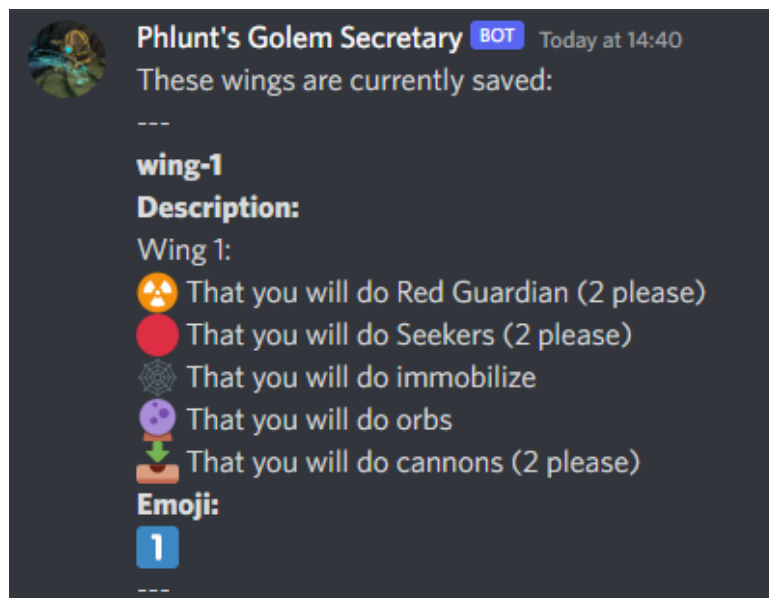
- **\$create wing (name of the wing) (description of the wing)**



The bot will then ask for confirmation by waiting for a reaction emoji. This emoji will be used in the future to represent the wing, so choose an icon that fits well.

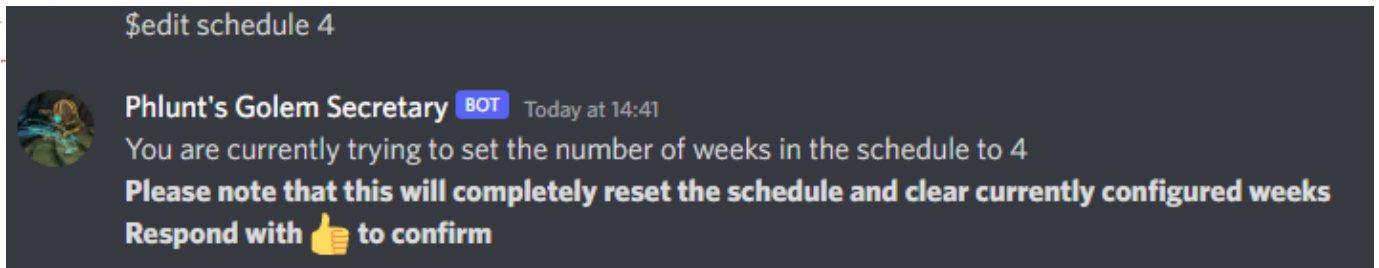
If you want to see the wings you've made, you can do so by typing:

- **\$display wings**



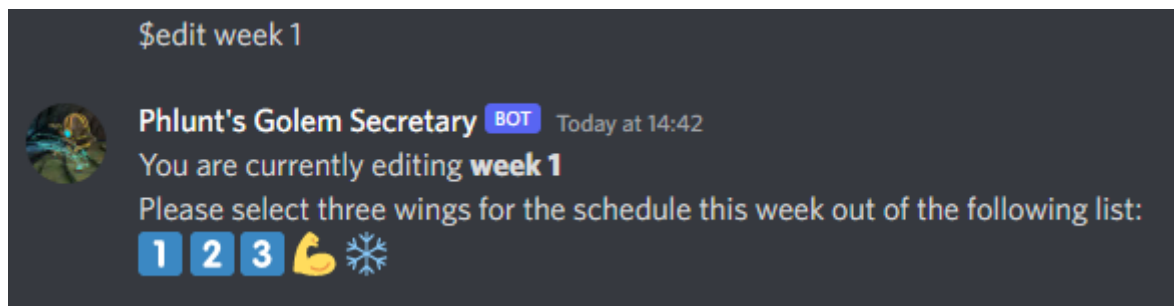
After we've made at least three wings, we can create a schedule. Enter the following command:

- **\$edit schedule (number of weeks in the schedule)**



The weeks in this schedule need to be filled with raid wings. We can do this by editing specific weeks:

- **\$edit week (number of the week)**



After a schedule has been made, the bot will follow the schedule to post messages to the chosen channel. These are the required steps to create a basic schedule, **but there are more commands to edit, view and delete data. To view these see the next chapter.**

Commands

The words written between brackets [], are arguments for the user to fill in, **without brackets!** To jump to a new line in Discord, press shift + enter. Lastly, if you do not answer a confirmation request (request for a thumbs up or other emoji), the bot will delete the message after a minute. You can always type **\$help** for a list of commands.

Configuration commands

- **\$set fractalchannel**
Sets the current channel as the fractal reminder channel.
- **\$set reminderchannel**
Sets the current channel as the reminder channel.
- **\$set raidchannel**
Sets the current channel as the raid schedule channel.
- **\$display config**
Display the general settings currently configured.

Raid wing management

- **\$create wing (name) (description)**

Adds a wing to the database. The description is optional and the name can't contain spaces.

- **\$edit wing (name) (new description)**

Adjusts the description and emoji of the specified wing. The new description is optional and the name is case sensitive.

- **\$delete wing (name)**

Deletes the specified wing from the database. The name is case sensitive.

- **\$display wings**

Direct messages you the entire database of wings that are currently saved.

Raid schedule management

- **\$edit week (number)**

Adjusts the wings contained in the specified week.

- **\$edit raidmessage (new message)**

Adjusts the general message that will always be added to the raid schedule message. The message is optional.

- **\$edit schedule (number of weeks)**

Adjusts the number of weeks in the schedule. Please note that this will wipe the schedule, removing all currently configured weeks. This will also set the current week to week 1.

- **\$set week (number of the week)**

Adjusts the current week in the schedule to the given number. If this number is greater or less than the number of weeks in the schedule, the current week will be set to week 1 instead.

- **\$toggle raids**

Turns the weekly automated raid schedule on or off. Weeks will still progress as normal but you won't receive messages.

- **\$display schedule**

Direct messages you the entire schedule that is currently saved. This will include the wings that are currently configured for each week.

- **\$display raidmessage**

Direct messages you the currently configured general message. This is the message that is always included with the raid schedule message.

- **\$create schedule**

Forcefully sends the scheduled message for this week to the raid channel.

Fractal event management

- **\$toggle fractals**

Turns the daily automated fractal events on or off. Days will still progress as normal but you won't receive messages.

- **\$create fractals**

Forcefully creates a fractal event in the fractal channel.

Reminder messages management

- **\$toggle ass**

Turns the weekly automated Antique Summoning Stones reminder on or off. Weeks will still progress as normal but you won't receive messages.

- **\$create ass**

Forcefully creates an Antique Summoning Stones reminder in the reminder channel.
